TOURNAMENT INFORMATION:

- **Rising Seniors or Juniors that do not have a team can register as an Individual.** Coaches will be appointed by the IWLCA and tournament management.
- **Individuals: limited to the first 24 players (1 teams).**
- **ALL FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE!**
- **Uniforms:** An assigned jersey will be given as part of the uniform. **Black shorts will be required to complete uniform.** It is the responsibility of the individual to buy or bring black shorts.
- **Overnight Accommodations:** All hotel reservations must be made through the www.ths.com. Blocks of rooms have been reserved for this tournament.
- The IWLCA Champions Cup game times are Fri (6/15) 5pm – 10pm; Sat. (6/16) 8am-9pm and Sun. (6/17) 8 am- 6pm.
- **All Champions Cup Individuals will have a practice on Friday night. Registration will be at 4pm.** Schedule travel plans accordingly.
- **Forfeit check will be voided if you: attend all scheduled games, attend mandatory meeting Friday evening, and if you stay in a hotel within the ths.com network.**
- IN CASE OF INCLEMENT WEATHER, the tournament reserves the right to alter game times, format, and/or playing site and surface!

- **WEATHER INSURANCE POLICY:** In the event that The All-American Showcase is cancelled, there may be a portion of the entry fee refunded.

REGISTRATION PROCEDURES:

- 1) The application must be completed in its entirety!
- 2) A **non-refundable** payment of **\$85** will be accepted on first come, first serve basis to reserve your spot.
- 3) A **separate \$25 “forfeit fee” check** must be sent with payment and registration form (will not be processed unless requirements are not met).
- 4) **Due with application: signed UNITED SPORTS WAIVER** for each player, forms can be found on the United Sports website: www.unitedsports.net.

REGISTRATION/CHECK-IN:

All Individuals are REQUIRED to check-in and register themselves at United Sports on Friday evening June 15, 2012 at 4pm. Any players with **missing waivers** will be **disqualified**.

ROSTERS: All rostered players are **required** to be USL members and have a **current USL membership number**. No players will be permitted to be double rostered. Players who are under the grade requirement for a division may NOT play up. If you are not a current member of US Lacrosse, one MUST join at the time of registration. Forms will be available.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

RULES OF PLAY: US Lacrosse Women's Rules will be used for Champions Cup.

DURATION OF GAME: All games have 2 x 25 minute halves running clock. There are 5 minutes before the start of each game. There will be NO TEAM TIMEOUTS DURING ANY GAME. A central horn will be used to start and stop games. Teams are urged to be ready to play at the start of the horn. Referees have the authority to start or end a half early to keep the games on schedule. (See below).

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions will be according to US Lacrosse rules.

PLAYERS EQUIPMENT: It will be at the officials' discretion to determine the safety and suitability of player equipment including the wearing of an orthopedic cast or hard brace. Mouth guards and eye protection are mandatory for all players.

INCLEMENT WEATHER: Teams should check our weather hotline before leaving for United Sports in case there are any field changes due to weather conditions: **610-466-9744**. All players should have indoor shoes in case games are moved inside. The schedule may be modified if necessary due to inclement weather or poor field conditions. 3 long blasts of an Air horn = LIGHTNING... clear all playing fields IMMEDIATELY. We must have 30 min. of NO Lightning, before returning to fields. Players and fans may go into the United Sports building or into their cars. All fields will be cleared.

COACHING: All Coaches have total responsibility for the conduct of their players, substitutes, friends and spectators at all times. Coaching from the sideline (giving direction to one's own team on points of strategy and position) is permitted, provided:

- ◆ The tone of the voice is instructive and not derogatory;
- ◆ Each coach or substitute remains on their own half of the field between the substitution area and the restraining line.
- ◆ No coach, substitute, or spectator makes derogatory remarks or gestures to the umpires, other coaches, players, substitutes, or spectators;
- ◆ No coach, substitute, or spectator uses profanity or incites, in any manner, disruptive behavior.

YELLOW AND RED CARDS: A player receiving a yellow card will be suspended from play for 2 minutes. The team will play down in both the offensive and defensive ends of the field. There must always be 4 field players, plus a goalie, behind the restraining line. During this time, their respective team will play down a player. A player or coach receiving two yellow cards in a single game is considered to have been given a red card. A player or coach who has been ejected will not be allowed to participate in the next scheduled game. A player or coach who is ejected for **violent conduct** or **serious foul play (Red Card)** may be subject to not participating in the remainder of the tournament. Any player or coach who assaults another will be expelled from the tournament. Ejections are determined by the referees; expulsions by the tournament directors.

SUSPENDED AND TERMINATED GAMES: If in the opinion of game officials, a game must be suspended for any reason the game may be resumed but is subject to being ended not less than five (5) minutes prior to the scheduled start of the next game. If in the opinion of game officials, a game must be terminated for misconduct of players, bench coaches, or spectators, the offending team could be suspended from further play and forfeits that game and all remaining games.

INJURY: Delays of the game due to injury may result in shortened game times. All games must end 5 min prior to the next scheduled game on that field. Ice for injuries will be placed at the center of each

sideline. Field Marshals will be assigned to each field and can summon the trainer to your field in case of injury or emergency.

HOME TEAM: The Home Team will be the team that appears first on the game schedule. The Home Team will supply the game ball, unless supplied by the Tournament. The game ball will be subject to Umpire approval. **The Home Team will be required to switch to alternate jerseys/or wear pinnies to accommodate a color conflict as declared by the umpire.** If the Home Team cannot supply alternate jerseys, the Visitor Team will change. The Home Team should be on the Left Bench when facing the field. Teams are on the SAME SIDE. Spectators are opposite the bench areas.

OVERTIMES: No overtimes except in the Semi-final and Final games of the Champions Cup Division. Point system will be used to figure out standings at end of pool play.

FORFEITS: Teams failing to report to assigned games will not be invited back next year and will forfeit the forfeit fee.

DISPUTES: All disputes will be settled by the Tournament Director or his/her designee and the decision will be final.
