



## United Sports Summer Camp 2012 FAQ's

1. **How do I enroll my child(ren)?**

There are several ways to register. You can go to our website, [www.unitedsportscamps.net](http://www.unitedsportscamps.net) and download the registration form and either mail it to us or, you may bring it in person to the information desk at United Sports, or you can register online or fax the form to us. Upon receipt of your registration form and the \$75 deposit per camper per session, you will receive a confirmation email notifying you of your camper's admittance to camp.

2. **What type of screening and training do your counselors go through?**

Our counselors are personally interviewed by one of the full-time Camp Directors. We hire only those who demonstrate a passion for working with children and those with prior experience working with kids. All counselors are required to complete a state police criminal record check and submit a child clearance form to the Department of Public Welfare. We also check references for those who are interviewed. In addition, all staff attend a staff training session where topics such as positive discipline, listening skills, group work skills and first aid and emergency procedures are reviewed.

3. **How do the parents know what activities their child will be doing?**

Each camp has a weekly curriculum which is posted on our website. For special events or on days when special equipment/clothes/supplies will be needed, notes will go home with each camper. In addition, a monthly calendar is also posted on our website noting all activities for all camps.

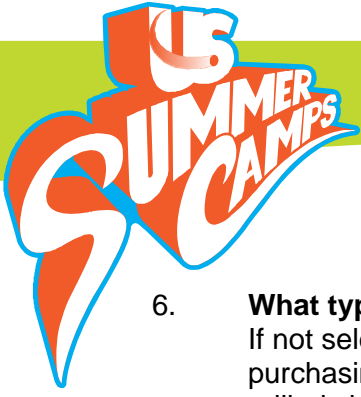
4. **What is the difference between Total Sports Camp and Premier Sports Camps?**

The main difference between the two camps is the amount of time spent learning specific sports skills. Premier Sports camps focus on one sport; soccer, field hockey, lacrosse, in-line hockey, basketball and volleyball and the development of skills designed for the athlete to take their game to the next level. Total Sports camp is designed for the multi-sport athlete who is looking for a well rounded experience in many sports and the skill level varies from the less experienced athlete to the more experienced.

5. **What should my child bring to camp?**

Campers should bring:

- Bag lunch labeled with your child's name (if not using the meal plan option)
- Water bottle
- Hat and sunscreen (for Premier Sports Campers and for water activity days)
- Athletic footwear (please no sandals or flip flops)
- Sport specific equipment for Premier Sports Camps (as deemed necessary by the camp director)
- Bathing suit and towel (check the website for water activity days)



6. **What type of lunch options are available?**

If not selecting to purchase the lunch option, a bag lunch should be brought to camp. If purchasing the lunch option, the menu will include child favorites including hot dogs, grilled cheese, chicken fingers, and pizza. 2 entrees will be offered each day and the lunch will include chips, a drink and a cookie. The summer camp menu will be posted on our website in May.

7. **Do you offer extended care?**

Yes, we offer both a morning and afternoon extended hours. Morning extended hours begin at 7:30am and runs until the beginning of camp at 9am. Afternoon extended hours begin at the end of camp at 4pm and ends at 6pm. A discounted price is offered to those who need both morning and afternoon care. Extended hours for half-day Pee Wee camp runs until 1pm.

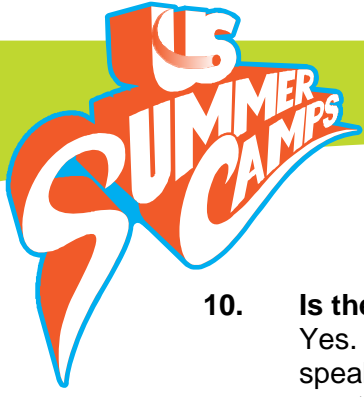
8. **What is the drop off and pick up policy and procedure?**

Safety is our number one priority at United Sports and our procedures for drop off and pick up reflect this.

- Morning drop off will take place as follows:  
For morning extended hours campers, parents must drop off inside the facility in the Aviator's restaurant and sign in their child with the extended hours staff.  
For those not needing morning extended hours, **on Mondays, every camper is dropped off inside the facility.**  
**Tuesday through Friday** the drop off location is as follows for each camp:  
Pee Wee Camp – back entrance by field house  
Action Day Camp – Front entrance  
Total Sports Camp – Front entrance  
Premier Sports Camps – curbside by specific outdoor fields
- Pick up procedures are as follows:  
Parents must sign out their child with a counselor. Parents and those picking up children will be **required** to show a photo ID. This will take place either inside the building or at curbside as follows:  
Pee Wee Camp – inside the facility – Party Room 2  
Action Day Camp – inside the facility – Hill Room  
Total Sports Camp – inside the facility – Sport Court  
Premier Sports Camps - curbside outdoors
- If someone is picking up a child who is not on the original **eligible to pick up list**, parents must call United Sports before the end of the day to inform staff of this change and also provide the name of the person picking up the child(ren). United Sports staff will only be able to dismiss campers whose parent or authorized adult shows a photo ID whose name is on the pick up list.

9. **What is the refund policy?**

For refunds prior to the beginning of a session, all requests must be made in writing at least one week prior to the start of camp. **After a camp week has begun, refunds will not be permitted except in the event of a medical issue. In this case, a refund will be processed only with a physician's note.** Refunds that are processed will be paid minus the \$75 deposit.



- 10. Is there a time to meet with the Camp Directors and staff before camp?**  
Yes. If you are interested in meeting a Camp Director, please call United Sports and speak directly to the director. The director will schedule a mutually agreeable time to meet with you and your child.
